

## **Mnemonics wins \$38M Contract to build Remote Activation Munition Systems (RAMS)**

*Melbourne, Florida, USA – August 17, 2018* – The US Army Contracting Command – New Jersey at Picatinny Arsenal, NJ awarded a 3-year Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract, valued at approximately \$38M to Mnemonics Incorporated for the production of the Remote Activation Munition System (RAMS) M152/Mk152 MOD 0, on Friday 03 August 2018.

The initial Delivery Order 0001 was also awarded to Mnemonics with the base contract in the amount of \$9.67M, for the delivery of complete First Article Test quantity, and production systems in support of the Program Management Office for Close Combat Systems. The RAMS is a man-portable, remote-activation system capable of initiating demolition devices, munitions or explosives at stand-off distances via secure radio links. The RAMS is primarily utilized by Special Forces, Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) and Army Combat Engineer units in all geographic areas and weather conditions where combat operations would be performed.

“The RAMS is a critical system for our nation’s warfighters, and Mnemonics is proud that we can contribute to their mission success with our production capabilities,” said Ron Frye, Mnemonics’ Corporate Director of Business Development. “The RAMS will be another great addition to the portfolio of Department of Defense avionics, electronic warfare, communications, weapons control and sensor products that Mnemonics has designed and produced over its 39 year history.”
